




AMTA Liability Insurance

BeingUndone

s we look back into our past, we recognize important moments that began something that would unknowingly change our lives forever: a brief mention years earlier of a gentle bodywork that a friend thought I would love because it embodied the energetic way I worked with my clients, a soulsearching conversation with a spouse about finding passion, purpose, and direction in my life, an information seeking phone call into the abovementioned body work, and the gut decision to sign up without knowing anything about it.

All those things led me to a Phase 4 class in which the words "During the course of this program this work will change you in a profound way" were spoken. I wasn't prepared to

be undone in that first class, to have to begin to re-evaluate all the stories I created about who I was, and what I had to offer the world. I certainly wasn't prepared to realize I navigated my world solely from my head, never trusting that inner wisdom.

Each class I attended, I gathered the knowledge and felt the work, and still I tried to find a way to make it all fit in with the old patterns I had lived with for so long. I had instructors who held space for me while I healed, who patiently guided me to understanding that no matter how many times I asked, Ortho-Bionomy is not linear and there is no techniquebased response. They continually allowed me to find healing for myself in the world I tried so desperately to shape according to my own need for safety with control. They met me with ease; they held no agenda; they helped me to honor what rose up in

me, and to not label it or define it so I could put it in a box and make sense of it. I learned about rightrelationship not only within Ortho-Bionomy, but in my own relationship with myself.

How do you explain being undone over and over again, until one day you realize you have actually been remade?

I very clearly remember the sobbing trauma loops, and the utter horror of realizing I had shut off my enteric system in childhood to survive. Washed over by the grief as I lay on the floor of a public restroom mourning the loss of connection I could have had, I could see the narcissistic patterns in my relationships where I struggled to have compassion and empathy for the people I loved the most. The daily moments in class unveiled another level of coping mechanism of stories I created in my



life that no longer served me. These were the moments my classmates and instructors would share the beautiful gifts they saw in me and held space for me to begin to step into my power and own them. For months I decided it was all too hard and I disconnected myself from the world and Ortho-Bionomy, and for a long time I licked my wounds. While the world moved around me I was suspended in my agony, rage, and depression-then slowly - oh so very slowly I came into the self-recognition that I had honored what rose within me, even if it was ugly, and with old patterns-I did my best to move forward in non-judgment- doing more with less, and with ease. I felt the reflexes move into my system, and in a life changing moment I felt the Space between the notes quiet my body, mind and spirit.

For the first time in my adult life,
I fit in my own skin, I realized I was
more than enough, and that I would
change the world- not because of
anything I did, but because I exist.
My very existence and who I am
are exactly who this world needs.
Greatness doesn't come from fame or
monumental discovery or wisdom.
It comes from the knowledge that I
am going to know failure and I still
chose to be brave and present. I now
know that the vulnerability of showing

up and taking a chance is the very thing that will make me unstoppable.

Ortho-Bionomy changed me in a profound way, in a painful way, in a turning-me-inside-out and shaking out the unneeded pain and beliefs kind-of-way. I have access to the ability to change and to hold the possibility of greatness within myself. I can run time forward to bring back the glow of my future success. I feel and meet regret that rises up within me, and then I set it free. I believe I am enough.

I began this journey looking for purpose in my own life and the skills to heal and bless others. Instead, I received the knowledge within myself that I had purpose all along, and that as I stepped into that purpose it became less about skills and more about the ability to engage with others from a healthy nervous system, to meet them where they are at, and offer them other choices when they

are ready to engage. I am a better human, a better wife, mother, daughter, sister, and friend. I carry compassion within me, and I engage the world more regularly with empathy as I recognize patterns of trauma and struggle all around me. 

Practitioner (PRC) Instructor (IRC) Review Committees Quarterly Evolvement Cycles

- Submissions due by March 15th, June 15th, Sept. 15th, Dec. 15th
- Items: Waivers, Practitioner, Advanced Practitioner, & Instructor submissions.
- Review final checklist with Advisor (s) and get all signatures needed.
- Compile all paperwork in the correct order see the checklist on the program handbook.
- Scan into a single PDF. (If you do not have a scanner, visit your local Kinko's, Staples, or public library, and save your scanned pages onto a USB Flash Drive.)
- All dues and fees must be up to date for the evolvement packet to be submitted to the review committees.
- Email completed portfolio to <u>office@ortho-bionomy.org</u> and, be sure to copy your Advisor.
- The SOBI office will confirm receipt of materials received and notify applicants of the Review Committee results on or before the next evolvement cycle.
- Keep original copies of all your paperwork for your records.


